

Each passenger entrance door provides a 35 by 81 inch opening. The doors retract upward inside the cabin between the interior trim and the fuselage skin. Normal operation of the doors is by an actuator powered by an electric motor. The motor is controlled by switches located inside the cabin and on the fuselage exterior in front of the forward door and aft of the rear door which are accessible from the ground.

Hydraulically actuated passenger stairs are optional integral equipment carried with the airplane at all times. The stairs have hand rails and are designed to retract to a stowed position directly inboard of the forward door,
