WHEREAS, aviation impacts every sector of our communities and state; and

WHEREAS, many North Dakota businesses use aviation as a tool for conducting daily operations, including the transportation of personnel and freight, air emergency service and medical evacuation, wildlife control, and law enforcement observation; and

WHEREAS, North Dakota's aviation industry promotes the state's diverse economic opportunities by enabling development efforts, and creating opportunities for communities, businesses, and citizens; and


WHEREAS, beyond the movement of goods and services, the state's aviation industry supports thousands of jobs and contributes over \$1.6 billion annually to the state's economy; and
